**Insurance:** The Camp Insurance is secondary coverage with a maximum benefit of \$5,000.00 per incident. **All claims made will need to be filed with the individual's insurance provider first. Camp insurance is supplemental and covers expenses the individual's insurance does not cover.** Camp insurance only covers accidents that happen while the individual is at camp. The family will bear the full responsibility for charges related to causes other than accidents, or charges not covered by, or beyond the \$5,000.00 maximum of the camp insurance.

**Pictures & Videos:** We authorize the KYM to use our child's likeness in photographs or video in any and all of its publications and media. We will make no monetary or other claims against the District for the use of such photos or videos.

**Admission:** It is the policy of the KYM camps to admit all persons without regard to race, color, national origin, sex, or handicap. The same requirement for admission is applied to all persons without regard to race, color, national origin, sex, or handicap. There is no distinction of eligibility for or in the manner of proving services by this agency. All facilities of the agency are available regardless of race, color, national origin, sex, or handicap. ## SUMMER CAMP INFORMATION & POLICY

### Registration Fees:

Early Registration	\$149.00 (if paid in full 14 days early)
Standard Registration	\$165.00 (\$50 deposit 14 days early with balance of tuition paid at check-in)
Deadline	All Registrations have to be postmarked 7 days before selected camp.

We strongly recommend utilizing the early registration. A completed application and a total \$149 payment in full is due to qualify. Also, payment for pre-orders are due with application and registration. The remainder of the registration fees will be calculated and due the first day of the registered camp.

### Extras:\*

Pre-Order information and prices are listed on the registration form.

**\*Multi-Child Discount:** First registered child must pay full regular price, \$15 discount for each child thereafter. All discounts will be applied to the tuition total. See registration form for details.

**Refund Policy:** *\$50 of the registration fee is non-refundable.* If for some reason a cancellation is necessary, we must be notified in writing first. T-shirt, Camp Bank, and DVD money will be refunded for early registration. No refund is offered within 7 days before the first day of camp.

**Housing:** Campers must supply their own bedding. Roommates (in most cases) will be determined by the camp coordinator. Please utilize the space provided on the Camper Registration form to express your rooming preferences. While every attempt is made to grant requests, we cannot guarantee every request. Thank you for your understanding.

**Dress Policy:** Camp Crestwood is a Christian Camp; therefore, I am expected to dress appropriately at all times. Clothing with alcohol, tobacco, satanic, and sexual slogans are not allowed. Shirts with secular music groups on them are not allowed. Undergarments should never be in public view. Tight clothing is not allowed. No spandex. Short shorts are not allowed. **Visits and Calls:** Our camps are closed to individuals not registered as a camper or staff. This is for the safety and protection of all campers at our facility. If you would like to spend time with your camper, we recommend applying to help as a member of our camp staff and spending the entire week.

**Can I Instruct My Camper To Call Home:** Phone calls in/out are not permitted during the week of camp. All cell phones should be left home or in the vehicle they arrived in. As a part of our Camp policy, all electronic devices are prohibited.

**Opening and Closing of Camp:** Camp Check-in begins Monday 2:00P. Camp closes at 11:30A on Friday. *Campers will not be allowed access to the campgrounds until after check-in.*

**What to Bring:** Bedding, pillow, pajamas, recreational clothing, jeans/modest shorts, current medications, modest one-piece swimwear, spending money, Bible, socks & undergarments, personal toiletries, sweatshirt, bug spray, towel, sturdy shoes for rough terrain, notebook & pencil, plastic bag for dirty clothing, sun screen.

**What not to Bring:** Electronic equipment including radios, personal music players, MP3 players, I pods, video game equipment, water balloons & guns, knives, fireworks, firearms, tobacco, weapons, alcohol, drugs, pets, cell phones, cookware, food, personal dvd players.

**Spending Money:** The Manna Hut (snack shop) is open during free times for the purchase of food, beverages, and souvenirs.. Campers may wish to bring cash for the Manna Hut and Camp Store and offering for STL / BGMC. A BGMC/STL mission's offering is received during the week. (Recommended \$10-15 per day)

## SUMMER CAMP INFORMATION & POLICY CONTINUED...

**Lost & Found:** Please mark your camper's belongings. It is the camper's responsibility to check the office for lost items.

**Medications:** All medications are to be turned in to the first aid provider upon arrival. All medications brought to camp shall be clearly labeled to include: 1) campers name, 2) name of prescribing physician, 3) prescription number, 4) date prescribed, 5) name of medication, 6) directions for use.

**Rules & Regulations:** We should strive at all times to represent Christ well as Christians with proper consideration of others. Attendance at all scheduled camp events, morning sessions, recreation, meals, and the evening services is required. Room and grounds are to be kept clean and tidy. Campers must take care of property. Campers are responsible to pay for damage to their room and dorm. **If an offender cannot be found**, the cabin members will be charged equally. Campers are not to enter another cabin without the counselor's permission. Campers must be in bed and quiet by "lights out."

**Disciplinary Action:** No camper shall leave the grounds or go out of bounds without proper permission from the Camp Director. The lack of cooperation, unnecessary roughness, lack of respect for property or authority, leaving dorms/rooms at night after lights out, or an unwholesome attitude on the part of any camper will result in **discipline and/or expulsion** from the camp. Parents are asked to help in explaining these rules to their children and encouraging their compliance. Expense of transporting expelled campers home must be borne by the parents.

**Pre-Order Information:** It is essential that full payment is made at the time of application for any camp pre-order product (i.e. shirts, DVD, Manna Bucks, Camp Bank, etc.). If a student has questions regarding what was pre-ordered we will work diligently to resolve the issue quickly. Campers are encouraged not to wait if they have questions about their account.

**Camp Store:** Kentucky Youth Ministries/Camp Crestwood runs a Manna Hut with snack shop items and a camp store with t-shirts and other products. Campers should bring cash if they wish to make a purchase during the week. Credit and Debit cards are accepted in the camp store.

**Camp Bank:** The Camp Bank is for Kids Camp Only. Upon arrival the kids take their spending money to the Bank. Their will be a designated Bank worker that will transfer the cash into Manna Bucks. Manna Bucks can be spent at the camp store or the Manna Hut. It is a card worth either \$1, \$5, or \$10. When the child makes a purchase the amount that is spent is marked off of the card. Unused Manna Bucks will be refunded to the camper in cash at the end of camp.
